CONVOCATION SHIFTED TO STADIUM

Dr Martin Luther King will speak in the stadium rather than in the Men's Gymnasium on Monday, October 16, at 11 a.m. In case of rain, the convocation will be held in the gymnasium. Shifting to the stadium, which will accommodate the crowds expected for the lecture, was made possible when Jan Eakes, ASSSC President, arranged to have a temporary loudspeaker system installed. Bounded as it is by a busy railroad line, the stadium is not ideal for public lectures, but its size and the nearness of parking lots make it more suitable in good weather for large crowds than the gymnasium. The convocation speech, entitled "The Future of the Civil Rights Movement," is open to the public without charge.
